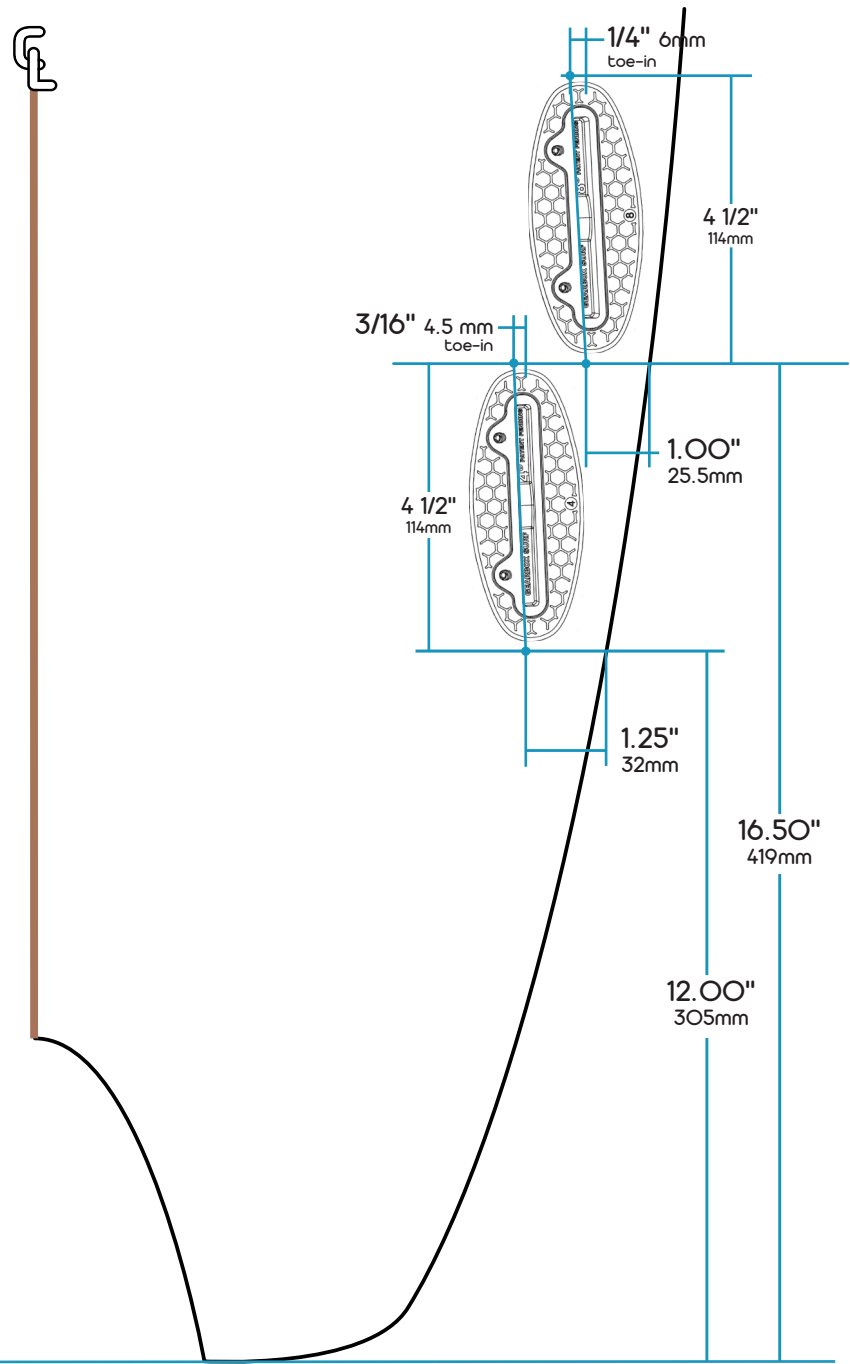


# Kneeboard QUAD Layout



## NOTE

If you have looked at our previous layouts note that we have adjusted the position of the back fin to reflect our latest thinking

This is our layout for a **QUAD** on a kneeboard. Typically, the back fin is placed the same distance in from the rail as the front fin, but on fishes the straighter outline requires the back fin needs to be shifted in a little more to keep some spread from the front fin. This should be considered a starting point for your own designs. Cant angles - 8° front and 4° back boxes.

We use a G Square for our fin layouts, so the fin base width is the standard 4.50" used on the square.
